

Working in Partnership to create Sustainable Community Projects

Course Outline

Public bodies, agencies and private organisations increasingly work with communities to deliver shared objectives. This one-day course explores the secrets of successful partnerships, and how to support the development and delivery of community projects that are sustainable in the long term.

Who is this course for?

For those working either in the public sector or in voluntary and community organisations who are interested in developing stronger partnerships and supporting community action that lasts.

What will this course cover?

- The different stages of partnership development
- How people work together inside a partnership
- Reviewing the partnership
- Developing an action plan
- Supporting community projects to become sustainable

What tools and knowledge will participants take away?

- An understanding of cross-sector partnership working and how to create successful partnerships
- Tools to develop an action plan, and to review how the partnership is working
- An understanding of community projects and tools to help them plan for the long term

What are the intended learning outcomes?

If participants apply what they have learnt on this course they will be able to develop effective partnerships between public sector and community organisations, and provide support to community organisations to help them develop sustainable projects.

Effective partnership working can bring the knowledge, skills, resources, flair and innovation of different partners together and apply them to create shared benefits. Sustainable community led projects help deliver economic, social and environmental benefits to communities.
